SchoolView Acceptable Use Policy

Simley High School is providing parent access to SchoolView as a means to further promote educational excellence and to enhance communications with parents. SchoolView allows parents to view their own child's attendance and academic performance on the web. For the opportunity to access SchoolView, every parent is asked to act in a responsible, ethical and legal manner. SchoolView is available to every parent or guardian of a student enrolled at Simley High School. Parents are to adhere to the following guidelines:

1. I will not share my passwords with others.
2. I will not attempt to alter, harm or destroy data.
3. I will not use SchoolView for any illegal activity, including violation of Data Privacy laws.
4. I will not access data or any account owned by another parent.
5. If I identify a security problem with SchoolView, I will notify Simley High School immediately.
6. I understand that if I am identified as a security risk to SchoolView, my access will be denied.

Commonly Asked Questions and Answers

-Why do some classes have many assignments listed in the grade book and others do not?

No two Simley courses are alike.

The volume of assignments/tests, and the speed at which they are corrected will vary from course to course and teacher to teacher.

-What should I do if an assignment is listed as missing?

Discuss the missing assignment with your child.

Once an assignment is turned in, it could be several days before a teacher corrects the work and records the mark in the grade book.

If a turned in assignment is listed as missing, and several days have passed since it was turned in, have your child discuss the status of the assignment with the teacher.

If your child has been unable to resolve the concern, contact the teacher directly.

-What should I do if my child disputes an assignment/test score as listed in the grade book?

Discuss the concern with your child.

Ask your child to discuss the mark in question with the teacher.

If your child has been unable to resolve the concern, contact the teacher directly.

What should I do if I believe my child's attendance in SchoolView is not accurate?

Discuss the concern with your child.

Ask your child to discuss the absence with the teacher.

If your child has been unable to resolve the concern, contact the teacher directly.

-What if I have children in multiple District 199 schools?

If you have children that go to more than one District 199 school, and more than one of the schools is using SchoolView, you will be asked to select a school when you first log on to SchoolView. If you wish to view data on your children who attend Simley High School, select Simley High School.

The names of your children who attend Simley High School will then appear. Click on their names to view data.

-What if I forget my user name?
